

Bassin' For Bucks

RULES

- All anglers are to have valid NS angling license
- All rules as stated with BBBA tournament trail shall be adhered too at all times
- Teams will consist of a maximum of two-angler teams
- Nine inch minimum length of smallmouth Bass allowed to be weighted
- Only one fish is allowed in the live well at weight in time (More than one smallmouth bass in the live well, will result in team disqualification for the tournament)
- Once a boat has crossed the check in point for weigh in (as determined by BBBA officials) their bass must be weighed in or released, and that check in time will register that boat for that hours weigh in slot.
- Teams can weigh in as many fish per hour as they wish (only one fish in live well at weigh in time)
- Winners of each hour slot are decided by weight of fish only, In case of a tie, then the length (longest fish) will determine the winner, If still tied, then the hour payout shall be split.
- All fish must be alive and releasable (Weight in officials well determine status of fish)
- Slot Size Limit hour from 1:30pm- 2:30pm, where there will be a Slot Size Limit payout to the heaviest fish with a length between 10” and 12”. There will be a biggest bass prize for that hour as well
- One team member must witness the weigh in and sign weigh in slip as witnessed, if contested, one re-weight is permitted at that time, that re-weight will be the final weight recorded as per BFB Staff. One team member is to bring the fish to the weight in scale, and return the fish to the water.
- In case of a tie, hour payout will be split equally amongst respective teams
- Trickle start as determined by number draw system (Teams draw in order of application form received by BBBA), No Boat shall be on plane when passing the starting boat.
- No Live bait allowed
- Pre fishing cut off, is the Sunday Prior to the tournament at 8pm
- BBBA Big Bass Snowball does not apply to this tournament
- No Boat shall be on plane when crossing the weight in point, when coming in too weight in fish. Failure to come down off plane will result in that hour Disqualification. Penalty will be decided by BFB Shore staff. BFB Staff decision is final
